Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for N Oak Trafficway Reconstruction - NE 42nd St to NE 46th St will be received at: 414 E 12th Street on 1st floor until 10:00 A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 8th day of July, at the office of the City of Kansas City General Services, Procurement Division, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed envelope addressed to the provided location.

The proposed work includes: The N Oak Reconstruction from NE 42nd Street to 46th Street will remove and reconstruct the existing section of roadway with an enhanced cross section that will include amenities to the area while incorporating elements from the North Oak Corridor Streetscape Master Plan.

Plans and specifications will be available online to all interested parties at the Kansas City, Missouri, Plan Room, <http://www.kcmoplanroom.org>. All addenda will be posted at this location. Any document or plan may be viewed or downloaded from this location

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Kansas City, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Kansas City, Missouri, reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 6%.
