Dear Consultant:

The Jefferson County Department of Public Works is requesting the services of a consulting engineering firm to perform the described professional services for the roadway improvement project described on the attached document.

If your firm would like to be considered for these professional services, you may express your interest by responding to the appropriate office which is indicated on the attachments. Limit your Letter of Interest (LOI) to no more than four (4) pages, which can exclude any submittal memorandum provided. This LOI should include any information which might help us in the selection process, such as the persons or team that you could assign to any given on-call project; the background of those individuals; and other projects your company has recently completed or are now active that might be relevant to this request for qualifications.

Jefferson County will evaluate firms based on a.) experience and technical competence, b.) the capacity and capability of the firm to perform the work in the timeframe needed, c.) past record of performance, and d.) proximity to and familiarity with the project area (reference: 23 CFR 172 Administration of Engineering & Design Related Service Contracts and RSMo 8.285 through 8.291).

It is required that your firm's current Statement of Qualification (SOQ) (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) and an Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020) be submitted with your firm's LOI or be on file with the Jefferson County Department of Public Works office. The SOQ is not included in the total page count limit for the LOI. **Please do not send Jefferson County five (5) copies of your SOQ.**

All letters of interest must be received by 4:00 pm, June 20, 2025, at the Jefferson County Department of Public Works, PO Box 100, Hillsboro, Missouri 63050.

Consultant Services Required:	<u>Roadway, Surveying, and Environmental:</u> Consultant shall be responsible for professional engineering services including the preparation of preliminary plans, right-of-way and easement plats, final construction plans, technical specifications and construction cost estimation. As part of preparing the plans the consultant may need to perform field surveys, archaeological or environmental studies and geotechnical investigations. The consultant shall also be responsible for a limited number of construction engineering services including staking of new right-of-way corners, setting of pins post-construction, review of shop drawings and material certifications, perform any needed drawing revisions and respond to requests for information from both the Contractor and the County.
