Description and Benefit

This innovation is a thin metal wand with six spray nozzles that attaches to a pressure washer. It is used to get into tight places when washing any type of equipment. It has a 360-degree swivel and rotating head that can flex 90-degrees each direction. The purpose for this innovation was to do a better job washing the salt and debris off our equipment to prevent rust and prolong the life of the equipment. By ensuring a better cleaning, we are eliminating unnecessary repairs and preventing rust which will help equipment last longer. To reach areas difficult to clean, workers would need to use a creeper to go under a truck which made salt, rocks and other debris blowing on them while in the tight area. Since we are able to reach those areas from the side of the truck, we are removing our employees from these hazardous conditions.
