A synopsis of the June 12, 2025 Cost Share Committee Meeting

Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Five projects were approved for \$13.4 million.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$10.3 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$11.8 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$34.6 million available in state fiscal year 2027, \$10.5 million available in state fiscal year 2028, and \$10.5 million available in state fiscal year 2029 for cost share projects.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$7.3 million available in state fiscal year 2025, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$9.0 million available in state fiscal year 2027, \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2028, and \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2029 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

MoDOT's Cost Share Program Partnerships Approved

City of Republic - \$7,712,886 to widen Route MM to four lanes from Route 360 to I-44.

City of Bolivar - \$3,012,500 to construct a roundabout at the intersection of East Loop Road and Route 32 and to construct turn lanes at the intersection of East Loop Road and Route 83.

St. Charles County - \$540,000 to construct a shared use path at the I-70 Foristell interchange (Route W and Route T).

City of Riverside - \$1,500,000 to construct roundabouts, ramp and roadway realignments to Route 9 and Riverway Blvd along Riverway Blvd corridor.

City of Riverside - \$669,422 to install lighting at the I-635 and Route 9 interchange.

The Cost Share Committee's next meeting is scheduled for September 11, 2025. Applications must be submitted by July 7, 2025.
