Sealed bids for MLK Pedestrian Bridge, HPP 3303(419), City Project #70232201, will be received at: 4600 E. 63rd St. Kansas City MO, 64130 until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 8th day of October 2025, at the office of the Parks and Recreation Administration Building, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of both paper and PDF to be delivered via sealed envelope addressed to Parks and Recreation Department, 4600 E. 63rd St. Kansas City MO 64130. "Bid Enclosed", title and Project Number are required on the envelope.

The proposed work includes: the construction of a new pedestrian bridge Brush Creek between US 71 Highway and the new Paseo Boulevard and modification of existing pedestrian trail improvements to connect to the new bridge approaches. Project commences south of Emanuel Cleaver II Boulevard, crossing Brush Creek and terminating near the existing MLK Park's parking lot.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Kansas City, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Kansas City, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
