KATY DEPOT – LIBERTY PARK CONNECT SEDALIA PROJECT**

Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for Katy Depot – Liberty Park Connect Sedalia Project, TAP5700(512), City Project Number 2026-015, will be received at: 200 S. Osage Ave., Sedalia, MO 65301 until 3:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 24th day of September, at the office of the City Clerk, and at that time will be publicly opened and read at the Council Chambers. All bids shall be submitted in the printed form contained in the Contract Documents in a sealed envelope marked on the outside “Katy Depot – Liberty Park Connect Sedalia Project” with the name of the bidder.

The proposed work includes: the construction of a 8-10’ sidewalk beginning at Katy Depot continuing west along the south side of 3rd Street to a mid-block crossing at Sneed Avenue. Tasks include: Demolition, Earthwork, Grading, Storm Sewer, Concrete Sidewalk, ADA Ramps, Signage, Pavement Markings, Traffic Control, and Erosion control.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from electronically from Jeremy Stone at jestone@cityofsedalia.com. A twenty-dollar (\$20.00) non-refundable deposit is required. Include a copy of your check in the email.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Sedalia hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Sedalia reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.
