Sealed bids for Truman Connected Phase 1 – STP-3301(524) (City Project No. 112102), will be received: via the Public Purchase website: <https://www.publicpurchase.com> until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 9th day of October 2025. The bids will then be publicly opened and read via Microsoft Teams at 2:30 P.M. on the date of the bid opening. The proposed work includes: the reconstruction of sidewalk, pavement marking, curb & gutter, roadway, hardscaping, and additional improvements to the roadways adjacent to and in the area of the project.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Independence, MO hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Independence, MO reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 8%.
