The proposed work includes: Sidewalk improvements South side of E 2nd St from S Grand Ave. to S Weber Ave. Then, continues on West side of S Weber Ave. from E 2nd St. to E 6th St. Also includes sidewalk improvements West of S Edison Ave. from W Front St. to W 2nd St. Installation of approximately 1,900 total linear feet of 5' wide, ADA compliant sidewalk.
