#### ADDENDUM #1

### IFB 25-121 STP-7302(698) ASPHALT OVERLAY 2026

This Addendum No. 1 modifies the original issued bid documents as follows:

### 1. MODIFICATIONS TO THE PROJECT BID SPECIFICATIONS:

- A. Change the DBE goal for this letting from a minimum of 7% of the total contract amount to a minimum of 0% of the total contract amount.
- B. Replace pages "Itemized Bid Form P-7 thru P-8" of the Project Specifications with pages "Addendum 1 Itemized Bid Form P-7 thru P-8".
- C. Replacement pages "Addendum 1 Itemized Bid Form P-5 thru P-7" modifies the following bid item quantities:
  - 622-10.01 \* COLDMILLING BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT FOR REMOVAL OF SURFACING (3 IN. THICK OR LESS)
    41,010 SQUARE YARDS to 48,120 SQUARE YARDS
  - \* The pay item quantity was changed to reflect additional milling needed at intersections on Old Hwy 79 and box culverts on North Point Prairie Road and revised field measurements.
- D. On page JSP-9, Job Special Provision D Construction Requirements, Section D.3 Tack Coat:
  - Change "Any tack coat that is necessary between the layers will be incidental and at the contractor's expense." to "The accepted quantity of tack coat will be paid to the nearest gallon at the contract unit price. No direct payment shall be made for water added to the asphalt."
- E. On page JSP-9, Job Special Provision D Construction Requirements, Section D.6.1
  - Change "The work shall be bid as a unit price per ton for asphaltic concrete overlay. The price per ton of asphalt shall include sweeping as required, tack coat, 2" overlay, and all incidentals, including traffic control and milling butt joints at locations necessary to match new and existing surfaces, such as end of overlay, bridges, box culverts, etc.." to "The work shall be bid as a unit price per ton for asphaltic concrete overlay. The price per ton of asphalt shall include sweeping as required, 2" overlay, and all incidentals including traffic control"
- F. On page JSP-9, Job Special Provision D Construction Requirements, Section D.6.1

Change "The monthly base price will be the price from the last published Asphalt Weekly Monitor® prior to MoDOT's monthly bid opening. For clarity, we will use the March 2015 price for the St Charles County opening of April 2, 2015 as the price at the time of bid." to "The monthly base price will be the price from the last published Asphalt Weekly Monitor® prior to MoDOT's monthly bid opening. For clarity, we will use the October 2025 price for the St Charles County opening of October 31st, 2025 as the price at the time of bid."

G. On JSP-69, Job Special Provision G – Estimated Quantities

Replace the quantities for 622-10.01 COLDMILLING BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT FOR REMOVAL OF SURFACING (3 IN. THICK OR LESS) with the following:

Dingledine Road = 29,844.00; S. River Road = 1,476.00; Old Hwy 79 = 8,243.00; North Point Prairie Road = 8,557

H. Add JSP J to the Job Special Provisions.

### J. RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACON ASSEMBLY

- **1.0 Description.** This work shall consist of furnishing and installing a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) assembly at the locations as shown in the plans. The installation shall comply with the latest version of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, with the specifications detailed on the RRFB detail picture on the following page, and with all manufacturers' recommendations.
- **2.0 Material.** The RRFB assembly shall include all equipment and material necessary for the installation of one (1) solar powered unit. This equipment includes, but is not limited to, 15' Signal Post, concrete base, signage, pedestrian pushbutton with APS, beacon, solar panel, control box, battery, wiring, mounting hardware and all additional equipment necessary for the installation of one solar powered unit which shall work in tandem with the adjacent RRFB across the street. All advanced signing associated with the crossing will be paid for separately from the contract plans.

**Solar Panel.** Solar panels shall be 65 watts with a minimum of a 50 amp hour battery.

**Posts and Base.** Standard pipe posts shall be round of outside dimension of 4.5". Posts shall be made of Schedule 80 aluminum alloy 6061-T6 manufactured in accordance with ASTM B429 and threaded on one end. Posts shall thread into a square cast aluminum base made of aluminum alloy 319. The base shall be FHWA certified and meet AASHTO break away requirements and shall include an 8.5" square handhold cover. Base shall be mounted on a concrete foundation and attached by four internal galvanized anchor bolts of standard size 1"x42". TAPCO or approved other manufacturer is acceptable.


**Pushbutton.** The installed pushbutton shall be compliant with the latest MUTCD, 11th edition in which the APS talking / vibrating pushbutton is required. Bulldog brand pushbuttons will not be accepted. The contractor shall include the manufacturer and model for the pushbutton as part of the shop drawing review. An acceptable product includes manufacturer Polara, Model XAV2E-LED or an approved equal.

- **3.0 Method of Measurement**. Measurement shall not be made for the work involved in furnishing and installing the one RRFB assembly but shall be considered a lump sum unit.
- **4.0 Basis of Payment.** All costs involved with the labor, materials including equipment, and tools necessary for this work as required by the manufacturer, will be paid for at the contract unit price for:

- 3. INSTALL PUSH BUTTON ON SIDE OF POLE FACING PEDESTRIAN RAMP.
- 4. ALL SIGNS AND BEACONS SHALL BE DUAL MOUNTED ON EACH SIDE OF POLE IN THE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC.
- 5. APS TALKING / VIBRATING PUSHBUTTON IS REQUIRED.

## 2. ANSWERS TO CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS FOR CLARIFICATION

**Q:** What asphalt areas receive 2" coldmilling.

**A:** The entirety of the existing asphalt surface within the project limits of Dingledine Road shall be coldmilled to a depth of 2". All butt joints, curb and gutter sections, bridge approaches, the intersections of Pieper Road and Montauk Drive on Old Hwy 79, and two NBI box culverts on North Point Prairie Road shall be coldmilled to a depth of 2" the entire width of the roadway. All other side street and paved approaches shall be milled per the detail on page TS-1.

**Q:** Are all curbs on Dingledine Road being removed and replaced?

**A:** No. Select curb and gutter sections as marked in the field will be removed and replaced.

**Q:** Is linear grading required at the guardrails?

**A:** Linear grading to provide the 2' shoulder behind the guardrail posts is required and shall be incidental to the guardrail construction.

Bidders shall sign this Addendum as acknowledgment and return it with the bid.
