General Summary

The assistant equipment technician serves in either a training role for full equipment technician positions or as a dedicated lube technician in the field. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

- High School diploma or GED/HiSET.
- Successful completion of a work simulation examination and a medical-physical examination.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

- Job requires heavy physical exertion and effort.
- Job requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment.
- Job may require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- 1. Serves as an equipment technician trainee by providing support and assisting equipment technicians during vehicle and equipment repair.
- 2. Serves as a lubrication technician by traveling to field locations to perform minor repair and preventative maintenance on light fleet and heavy construction vehicles.
- 3. Performs minor repairs to tires, motors, hydraulic systems, brakes, and glass; cleans engines or parts.

- 4. Performs yearly inspections on trucks and other highway vehicles.
- 5. Maintains repair and equipment records.
- 6. May fill reservation requests for backhoes, dozers, loaders, and other construction equipment.
- 7. Performs basic welding.
- 8. Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
