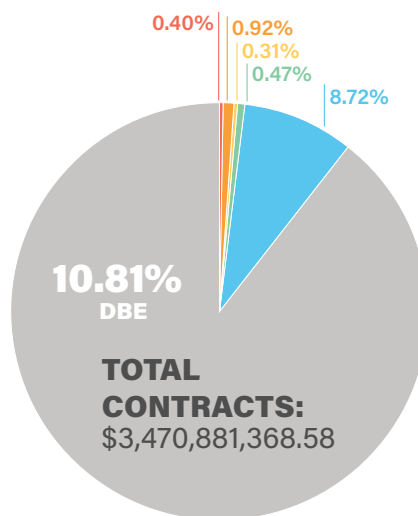


Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

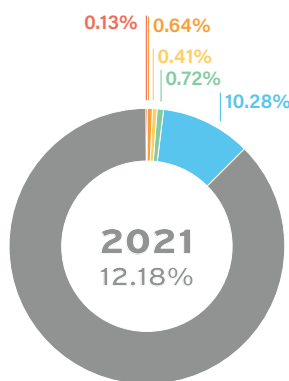

STATEWIDE TOTAL FFY 21-23

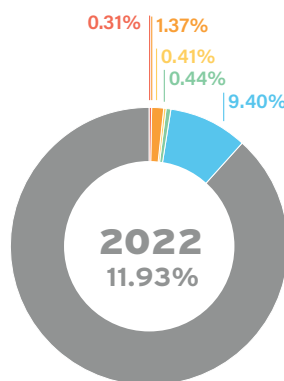

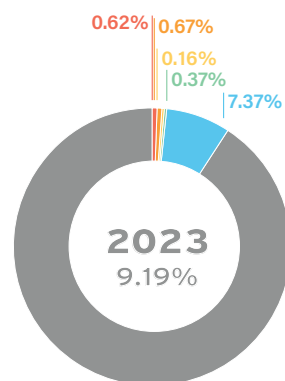
