General Summary

The facility operations specialist performs routine entry-level maintenance, renovation, and repair functions at department facilities and buildings. Responsibilities are performed under direct supervision.

Minimum/Required Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED/HiSET.
- Two years equivalent combination of post-secondary education and experience in a building repair and maintenance field such as carpentry, electrical wiring, facilities operation and management, HVAC, or related.
- Successful completion of a work simulation examination and a medical-physical examination.

Special Working Conditions/Job Characteristics

- Job may require occasional overnight travel.
- Job requires heavy physical exertion and effort.
- Job requires exposure to physical hazards, health and safety risks, and/or adverse or otherwise undesirable characteristics in the environment.
- Job may require operation of vehicles to plow snow and spread ice control materials.

Examples of Work

- **1.** Performs routine maintenance to building interiors and plumbing, electrical, heating, and air conditioning systems.
- 2. Assists with complex building repairs and renovations.
- **3.** Builds and assembles cabinets, shelving, counter tops, bookcases, tables and baseboards; moves and assembles furniture and partitions.
- **4.** Performs outdoor maintenance such as landscaping, mowing, and snow removal.
- **5.** May install and service liquid chlorine and salt brine pumps at salt buildings.
- **6.** Performs other responsibilities as required or assigned.
