A synopsis of the December 11, 2025 Cost Share Committee Meeting

Summary of Program Activity

- ❑ Four projects were approved for \$9.7 million.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$29.4 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$33.8 million available in state fiscal year 2027, \$15.8 million available in state fiscal year 2028, \$10.5 million available in state fiscal year 2029, and \$10.5 million available in state fiscal year 2030 for cost share projects.
- ❑ MoDOT's Cost Share Program has \$8.9 million available in state fiscal year 2026, \$9.4 million available in state fiscal year 2027, \$9 million available in state fiscal year 2028, \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2029, and \$4.5 million available in state fiscal year 2030 for cost share projects that encourage economic development.

MoDOT's Cost Share Program Partnerships Approved

DeLong's Incorporated - \$618,000 to construct a northbound acceleration lane on Route 63 and Route P, and widen the intersections at Route 63 and Route P and Business Route 63 and Route P.

City of Smithville - \$541,910 to install a new traffic signal system, ADA pedestrian accommodations and minor median improvements at Route 169 and Richardson Street.

City of Washington - \$5,654,806 to widen Route 47 to create a four-lane route with a center turn lane from Steutermann Road south approximately 4,000 feet and construct an intersection for the future East-West Parkway intersection.

City of Farmington - \$2,920,880 to add a turbo roundabout at Woodlawn Drive/Route 67 southbound ramps and Bray Road, and additional turn lanes and a traffic signal at Maple Street and Route 67 northbound ramps.

The Cost Share Committee's next meeting is scheduled for June 11, 2026. Applications must be submitted by April 6, 2026.
