


# 2026-2027 Southwest St. Louis County Construction Guide

## 2026

1. **Interstate 44 pavement repair** – The project completes road repairs between Route 109 and Route 141 in preparation for a later project. The project starts in early 2026 and should be complete later in the year.
2. **Interstate 55 bridge and pavement improvements** – This project resurfaces I-55 between I-44 and Lindbergh. This year, crews will complete any remaining rehabilitation on the southbound I-55 bridge over Union Pacific Railroad and resurface portions of the interstate and associated interchanges. This project should be complete in summer 2026.
3. **Interstate 55 sign updates** – This project reviews and replaces overhead signs along I-55 between the Poplar Street Bridge and the Ste. Genevieve County line. Work continues through late 2026.
4. **Interstate 64 sign updates** – This project reviews and replaces overhead signs along I-64 between the Poplar Street Bridge and I-70 in St. Charles County. Work continues through late 2027.
5. **Interstate 270 bridge replacement** – This project continues work to replace the I-270 bridge over Conway just north of the I-64 interchange. The project also widens and replaces the driving surface on the I-270 bridge over Ladue Road. Work should be completed by summer 2026.
6. **Route 21 roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signals and guardrail, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Route 30 and the Jefferson County line. Work continues through late 2026.
7. **Route 30 (Gravois) roadway improvements** – This project will update the section of Route 30 between Route 141 and the St. Louis city limits and then resurface the roadway. Includes signal and lighting updates as well as some updates to the sidewalk. Work should start in early 2026 and be complete in late 2026.
8. **Route 61/67 (Lemay Ferry) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signals and guardrail, updates sidewalks to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements and resurfaces the roadway between Lindbergh and the Jefferson County line. Work starts in early 2026 and continues through late 2027.
9. **Route 100 (Manchester) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks, and sidewalks between Route 141 and I-270 to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Includes replacing culverts at Grand Glaize and Glaize creeks, and bridge maintenance at I-270 and over Des Peres Road. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work will be completed in mid-2027.
10. **Route 141 at Interstate 44 at retaining wall repair** – This repairs a retaining wall on the ramp from southbound Route 141 to Interstate 44. Starts in early 2026 and should be completed later in the year.
11. **Route 231 (Telegraph) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between the city of St. Louis and Franklin Lane to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. Includes a reduction in the number of lanes in the Kingston portion between Telegraph Road and Ripa Ave. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2026 and continues through late 2027.
12. **Route 231 (Telegraph) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Franklin and the Meramec River to meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work starts in early 2026 and continues through late 2027.
13. **Route 267 (Lemay Ferry) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Lindbergh and River City Boulevard to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work will be completed in late 2026.
14. **Route 340 (Olive) roadway improvements** – This project resurfaces the roadway between I-170 and Ferguson Ave. (end of state maintenance), and updates sidewalks, signals and crosswalks as necessary to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. Also includes some updates to ADA between I-270 and I-170. Work starts in summer 2026 and continues through 2027.
15. **Route 366 (Watson) roadway improvements** – This project makes updates to signal, crosswalks and sidewalks between Geyer and the St. Louis city limits to meet Americans with Disabilities requirements. The bridge over Gravois Creek will be replaced this year, with one lane closed across the bridge in each direction. When the updates are complete, the roadway will be resurfaced. Work will be completed in mid-2027.

16. **Interstate 44 bridge maintenance** – This project completes preventative maintenance (crack filling) on the I-44 ramp between Route 141 and westbound I-44 and the flyover ramp from southbound 141 to eastbound I-44.
17. **Forward 44: Interstate 44 bridge and pavement rehabilitation** – This project replaces the left lane of I-44 pavement between Route 141 and Route 100 and rehabilitates the interstate bridges over Fox Creek, Williams Creek, Route 109, and Route 141 and rehabilitates two culverts (west of Lone Elk Park and west of Route 141). Work starts spring 2027 and be completed in mid 2029.
18. **Interstate 64 at Interstate 170 bridge rehabilitations** – This project rehabilitates the flyover ramps from southbound I-170 to eastbound I-64 and from eastbound I-64 to northbound I-170. Work should start in early 2027 and should be complete late in the year.
19. **Interstate 64 outer road resurfacing** – This project repairs pavement and upgrades guardrail on the north outer road from Spoede Road to west of Marsally Drive and from Conway Road to Mason Road and on the south outer road from Mason Road to Jennifer Lane, from west of Carole Road to Spoede and from Clayton Road to Rolling Rock Lane. It also includes resurfacing in those areas. Starts in spring 2027 and should be completed late that year.
20. **Interstate 64 resurfacing** – This project resurfaces both directions of Interstate 64 between Route 340 and Spoede Road. Also resurfaces the ramps between I-64 and I-270. This project starts in early 2027 and should be completed later that year.
21. **Interstate 64 bridge maintenance** – This project completes preventative maintenance (crack filling) on the westbound I-64 over the Missouri River (Boone Bridge). The project should start and be completed in 2027.
22. **Interstate 170 bridge rehabilitations** – This project replaces the Forest Park Parkway bridge and rehabilitates several bridges on I-170 between I-64 and Page Avenue. Includes the bridges over Galleria Parkway, Brentwood Boulevard, Clayton Road, and Ladue Road. Work starts in early 2027 and should be completed in late 2028.
23. **Interstate 270 bridge rehabilitations** – This project rehabilitates several bridges between I-44 and I-55. Rehabilitations include the interstate bridges over Marshall Road, Rott Road, Von Talge and the bridge that carries the ramp to northbound I-55 and Forder Road. At least three lanes should remain open in each direction on I-270. Work starts in 2027 and continues through 2028.
24. **Route 100 pavement maintenance** – This project fills cracks on the route between Interstate 270 and Big Bend. Work should start in early 2027 and be completed later in the year.
25. **Route 141 signal upgrade** – This project upgrades signals at Parkway South Middle School and at Springdale Lane. This starts in early 2027 and should be completed later that year.
26. **Route 340 pavement maintenance** – This project fills cracks on the route between Interstate 270 and Lea Oak. Work should start in early 2027 and be completed later in the year.
27. **Route 340 resurfacing** – This project resurfaces the corridor from Lea Oak Road to Route 100. Construction starts in early 2027 and should be completed later that year.
