


# MISSOURI ROUTE 32 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Dent County



## PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

**Type of work:** Bridge replacement.

**Construction expected:** 2027.

**Traffic impacts:** The roadway is expected to remain open with a one-lane bypass and temporary signals.

**Estimated cost:** \$4.6 million, including right-of-way acquisition, engineering, and construction costs. Subject to change.

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## PROJECT DETAILS

### Why is this work needed?

The Missouri Route 32 bridge over Huzzah Creek in Dent County, southwest of Viburnum, is slated for replacement in 2027. Built in 1931, the bridge is in poor condition, showing signs it has reached the end of its useful life, and, in need of replacement.

### Proposed improvements

- New 30-foot-wide bridge, 6 feet wider than the current bridge.
- Replacing current railings with new barriers.
- Installing new guardrail, pavement marking, and approach pavement.

### Traffic Impacts

Construction is expected to take place in 2027 and is expected to take approximately 6 months, subject to change.

The roadway is anticipated to remain open during construction, with a one-lane temporary bypass in place and temporary traffic signals directing motorists through the work zone.



### Current Proposed Timeline

- **Dec. 2026:** Contractors submit competitive bids.
- **Jan. 2027:** Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.
- **March 2027:** If awarded in January, earliest contractor may begin work.
- **Dec. 2027:** Anticipated project completion.
