Each trade is responsible for changes in its work caused by changes in the work of other trades. This addendum is a part of and shall be attached to the original set of plans and specifications for the work.

Clarifications:

State Wage Rates

Annual Wage Order 33 is now in effect as of May 28, 2026. This contract has been updated to reflect the change.

Tree Clearing Restrictions

Job Special Provisions have been updated to the most current guidelines for tree clearing.

Changes:

1. Job Special Provisions

a. **JSP 24, Paragraph 1 shall be replaced with the following:**

“This contract requires payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages for each craft or type of work required to execute the contract as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and requires adherence to a schedule of minimum wages as determined by the United States Department of Labor. For work performed anywhere on this project, the contractor and the contractor’s subcontractors shall pay the higher of these two applicable wage rates. The applicable state wage rates for this contract are detailed in “Annual Wage Order 33”, that is attached to this bidding document. The applicable federal wage rates for this contract are the effective Davis-Bacon federal wage rates posted the tenth day before the bid opening date and can be found at: <https://sam.gov/content/wage-determinations>. These supplemental bidding documents have important legal consequences. It shall be conclusively presumed that they are in the bidder's possession, and they have been reviewed and used by the bidder in the preparation of any bid submitted on this project.”

b. **JSP 59 shall be replaced with the following:**

“59. TREE CLEARING RESTRICTIONS

1.0 Description. The project is within the known range of the federally endangered Indiana bat, northern long-eared bat, and proposed endangered tricolored bat. These bats are known to roost in trees with suitable habitat characteristics during summer months.

1.1 To avoid negative impacts to these bat species, removal of any trees/limbs greater than three (3) inches in diameter shall only occur between October 16 and March 31.

2.0 Basis of Payment. No direct pay shall be provided for any labor, equipment, time, or materials necessary to complete this work.”
