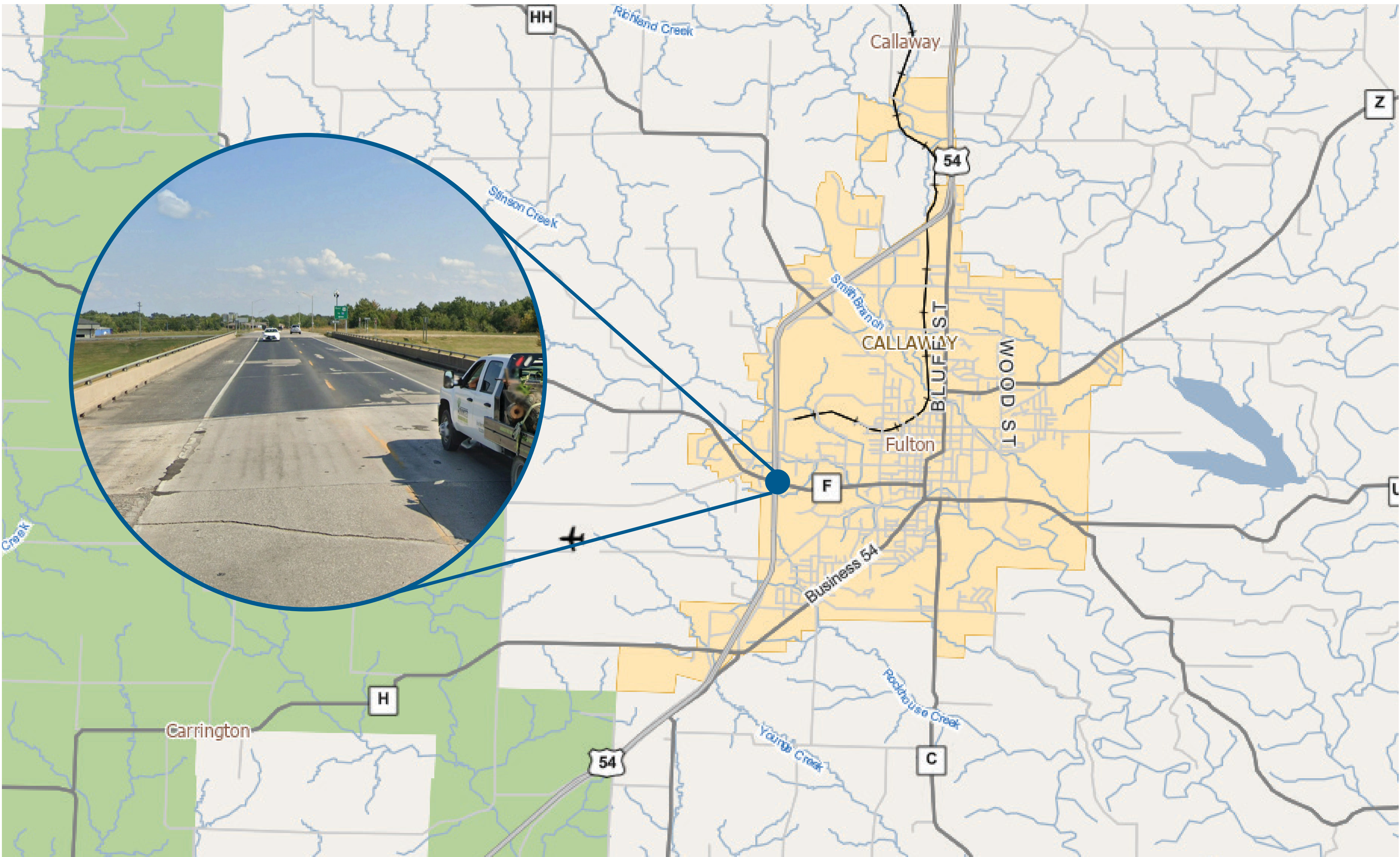


ROUTE F BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT OVER U.S. ROUTE 54 IN CALLAWAY COUNTY



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

Built in 1968, the bridge's supporting structure is in good condition, but the deck (driving surface) is deteriorating. The improvements include:

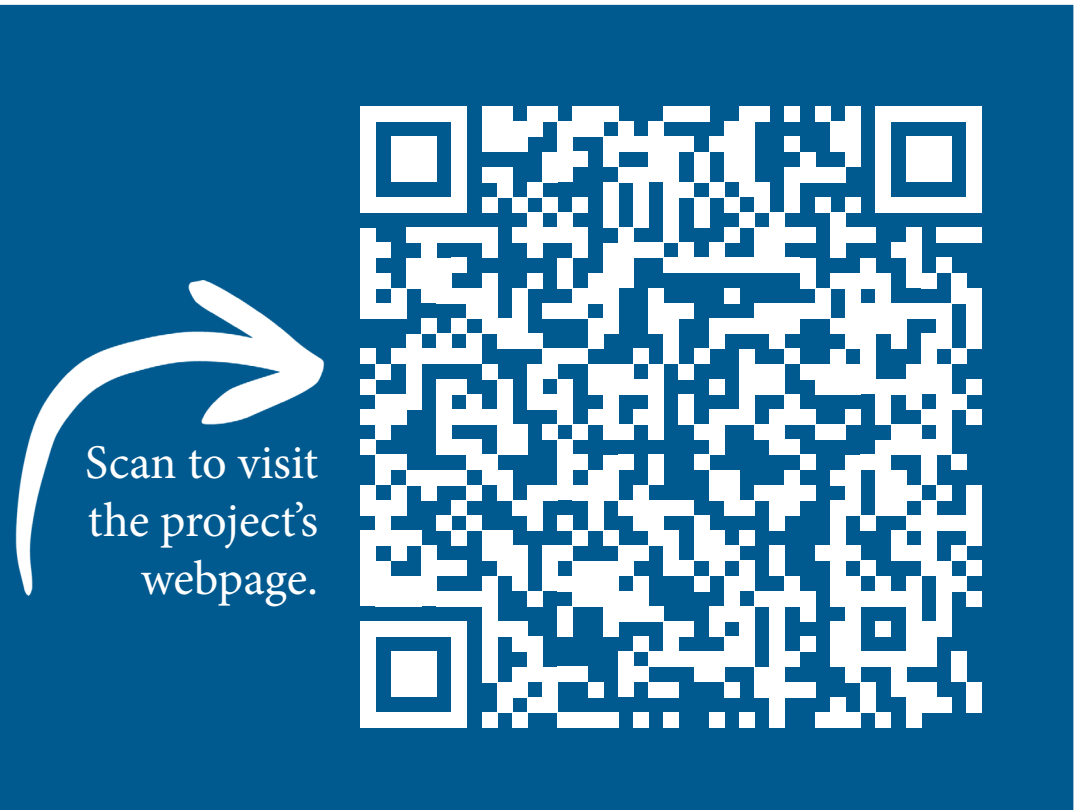
- New girders.
- New deck, the same width as the existing structure.
- Added beautification elements, including black fencing, stamped concrete barriers, and city signs, in partnership with the City of Fulton.
- New sidewalk on the north side.
- New approach pavement.
- Increased vertical clearance for vehicles traveling U.S. 54 to approximately 16 feet, 4 inches.

Estimated Cost

- \$3.7 million including right-of-way, engineering, construction costs, and aesthetic enhancements.

Current Project Timeline

- **February 2027:** Contractors may submit competitive bids.
- **March 2027:** The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award a contract for project.
- **May 2027:** If awarded, the earliest the contractor may begin work.
- **End of 2027:** Anticipated completion of work.



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
