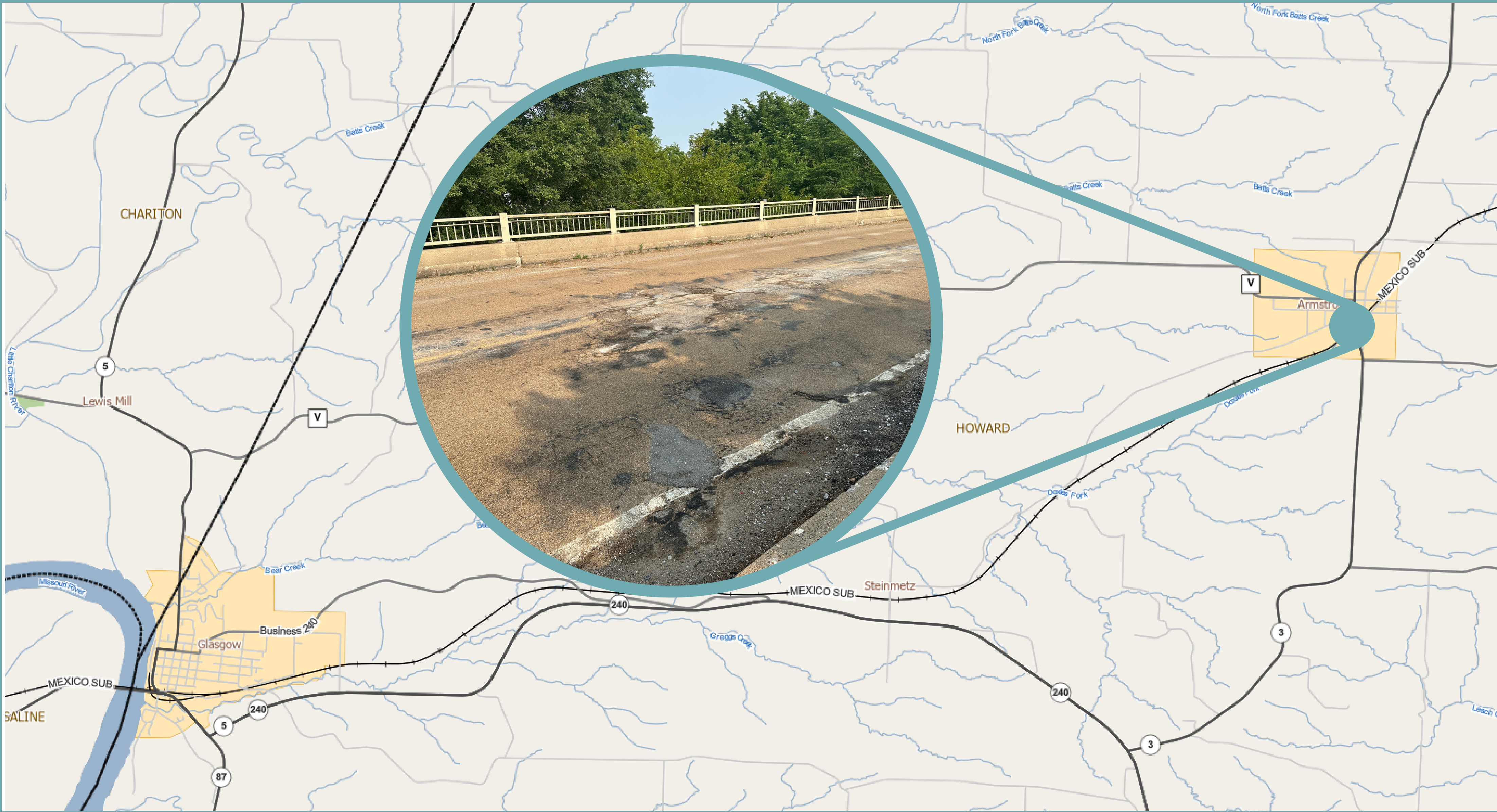


MISSOURI ROUTE 3 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OVER CPKC RAILROAD IN HOWARD COUNTY



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

The Missouri Route 3 bridge over CPKC railroad in Armstrong is in poor condition and showing signs it has reached the end of its useful life. The bridge replacement project is currently scheduled for 2027/2028.

Planned improvements include:

- Raising bridge to meet current railroad requirements.
- Replacing current railings with new barriers.
- Installing new pavement marking and approach pavement.

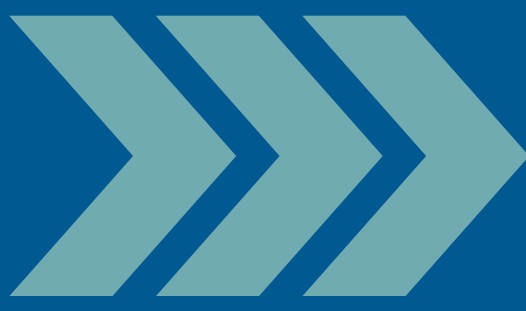
Traffic Impacts

Construction will require a full roadway closure for approximately 180 calendar days, subject to change. A signed detour is planned to direct motorists to use Missouri Routes 240, 5 and 3, and Howard County Route V.

Current Project Timeline

- May 2027:** Contractors submit competitive bids.
- June 2027:** Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.
- July 2027:** If awarded in May, earliest contractor may begin work.
- Dec. 2028:** Anticipated project completion.
