PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Type of work: Bridge replacement.

Improvements: Widening and raising.

Construction expected: 2027/2028.

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PROJECT DETAILS

Why is this work needed?

Built in 1934, the Business Route 240 bridge over CPKC railroad, east of Glasgow, is in poor condition and showing signs it has reached the end of its useful life. The bridge replacement project is currently scheduled for 2027/2028 and will include raising the bridge to meet current railroad requirements.

Traffic Impacts

Construction will require a full roadway closure for approximately 165 calendar days, subject to change.

A signed detour is planned to direct motorists to use Missouri Routes 240 and 5, and Business Route 240.

Proposed improvements

- New, wider bridge.
- Raising bridge to meet current railroad requirements.
- Replacing current railings with new barriers.
- Installing new pavement marking.
- Installing new approach pavement.

Current Proposed Timeline

May 2027: Contractors submit competitive bids.

June 2027: Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.

July 2027: If awarded in May, earliest contractor may begin work.

Dec. 2028: Anticipated project completion.



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
