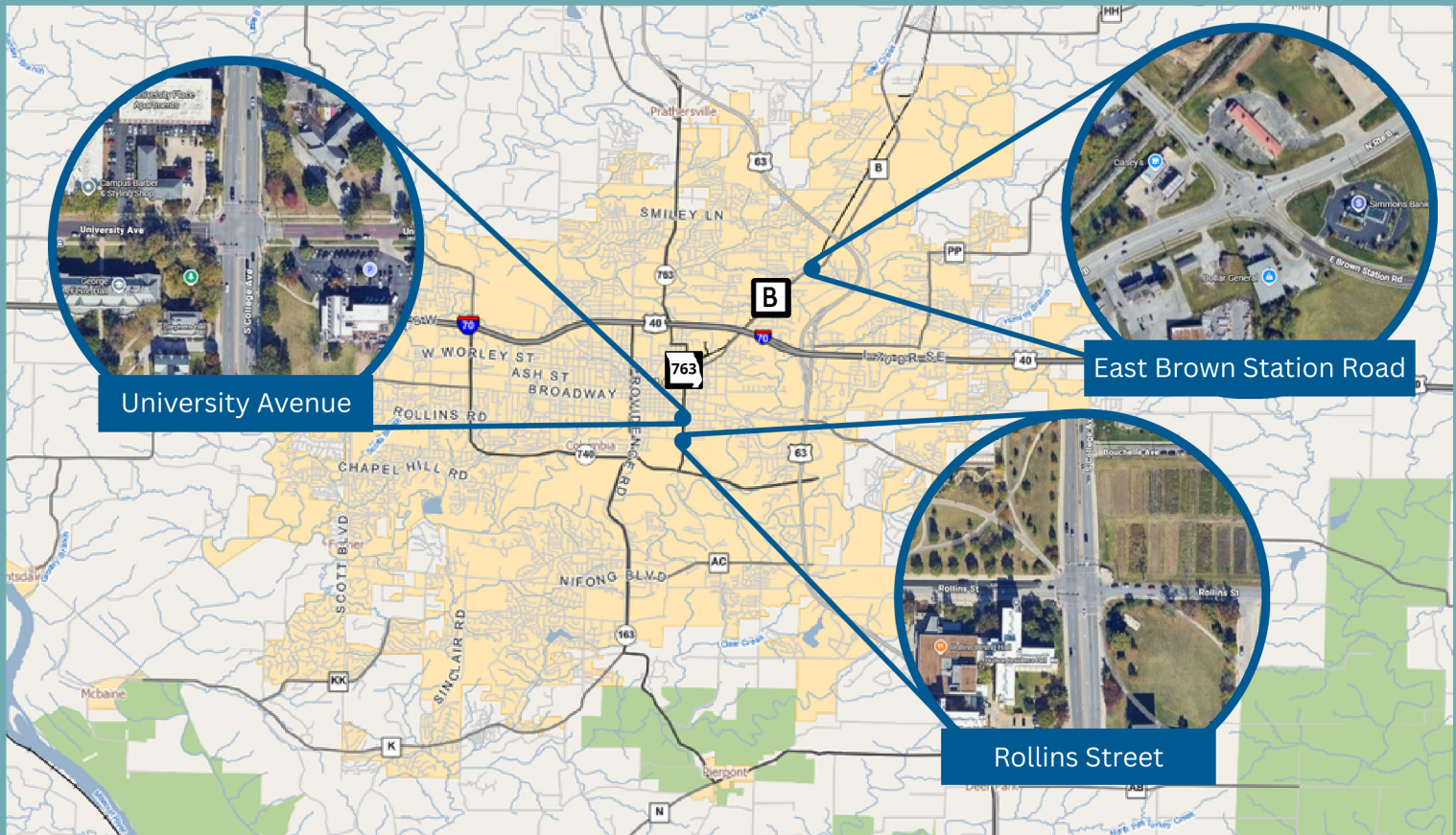


ROUTE B AND MISSOURI ROUTE 763 (Paris Road and College Avenue) INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Construction expected: 2027.

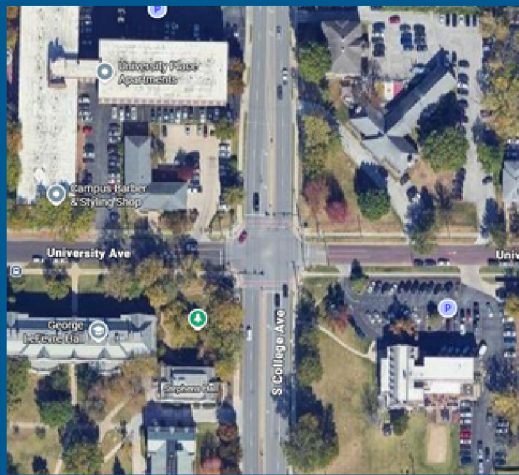
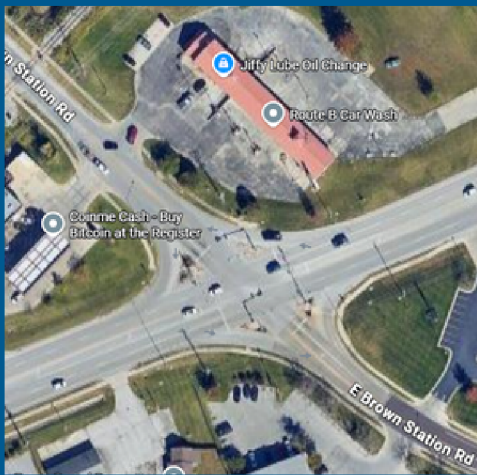
Estimated cost: \$700,000, including engineering, right-of-way, and construction costs. Subject to change.

PROJECT DETAILS

Why is this work needed?

The Missouri Department of Transportation is planning safety and mobility improvements at the intersections of Route B (Paris Road) and East Brown Station Road, and Missouri Route 763 (College Avenue) at both University Avenue and Rollins Street.

These locations were identified through safety evaluations that considered crash history, traffic conditions, and pedestrian activity. The proposed improvements are designed to enhance visibility, improve traffic signal operations and create safer, more predictable crossings for pedestrians while maintaining efficient traffic flow for motorists.

Proposed Improvements

- Route B (Paris Road) at East Brown Station:
 - Reconfigure right-turn lanes.
 - Upgrade left-turn signals for safety and traffic flow.
- Route 763 (College Avenue) at University Avenue:
 - Upgrade left-turn signals for safety.
- College Avenue at Rollins Street:
 - Add a westbound left-turn lane.
 - Upgrade left-turn signals for safety.

Traffic Impacts

Paris Road at East Brown Station Road:

- Staged construction to maintain at least one lane of traffic in each direction at all times.

College Avenue at University Avenue:

- Short-term lane closures expected.

College Avenue at Rollins Street:

- Eastbound Rollins Street to close from College Avenue to the first drive east of College Avenue (south side of the street) during the widening of Rollins Street.
- The driveway entrance on the south side of Rollins Street, just east of College Avenue, will be constructed in stages to maintain one open lane at all times.

Current Proposed Timeline

May 2027: Contractors submit competitive bids.

June 2027: Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.

July 2027: If awarded in May, earliest contractor may begin work.

Dec. 2027: Anticipated project completion.



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
