On behalf on the Johnson County Spirit Trails Coalition comprised of seven municipalities, the University of Central MO, and Whiteman AFB, we want to express our ongoing support of the Rock Island Trail across mid-Missouri. The first phase of the Spirit Trail between Warrensburg, Knob Noster State Park is underway heading on to Whiteman AFB's front door. The coalition has expended its county-wide comprehensive trail network plan to include three access points along the Rock Island 47 miles trail.
