<u>Anthem Claims Summary (2023/2024)</u> –Mr. Denkler reported that medical claims are about 15.5% higher when compared to this time last year.

MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2022/2023) -

Mr. Denkler reported that Plan paid costs saw a 5.1% decrease in August 2024, when compared to the same time last year. This is a YTD increase of only 3.7%PMPM.

<u>PillarRx Quarterly Update-</u> Mr. Denkler welcomed the PillarRx staff to the meeting. Pillar RX staff report our YTD trend is a 0.1% decrease through June 2024. The IPC Copay Assistance program has seen a net savings of just over \$1.4 million in the first half of 2024.
