Project Reaches Half Way Point Completion on Track for late Fall 2014

Route 94 to Motherhead

All nine miles are now cleared with the work up to Route 94. Grading work will continue from Route 94 to Gutermuth Road into early 2014. Trees will be mulched and recycled. Crews have begun working on the bridge walls at Motherhead.

Motherhead to Gutermuth

Through January, we will have rock blasting once daily on weekdays. The rock blasting is on the state property about half way between Gutermuth and Motherhead. Crews are hauling dirt during daytime hours from the Dardenne Creek area to Motherhead.

Gutermuth to Route K

Crews are working through the Dardenne Creek area on the grading for the new road. The bridges at Crooked and Dardenne Creeks and Tributary B will begin in early 2014.

Route K

Utility crews are almost complete relocating at Route K. Crews will begin installing drainage pipes and completing the fill material at what will be the ends of the bridges on either side of Route K. Watch for crews hauling material here in early 2014..

Between K and Bryan

Crews are installing the drainage pipes and completing the removal of the cross street pavements.

Bryan Road

Grading work continues for the Route 364 under Bryan Rd. and installing rock base.

Hanley Road

Crews are working on the pavement on either side of the new bridge. Grading work continues between Hanley and Henke roads.

Henke Road

Crews are working on the bridge so expect some daytime lane closures and flagging traffic on Henke at the intersection with Route N.

All work is weather dependent at this time of year.

A milestone was reached this month with engineering design work completed for the full nine miles.
