

Route 364/Page Phase 3 Construction Update

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KEY TRAFFIC INFORMATION

- Significant traffic changes are coming to the Route 94/Mid Rivers Mall Drive area.
- The public is strongly advised not to enter the project limits until the designated time of the public festivities. Trespassing on an active construction site is extremely dangerous even when it appears no work is going on.
- Watch for lane restrictions and flaggers directing traffic along the length of the project.

Completion Countdown: Route 94 Traffic Changes

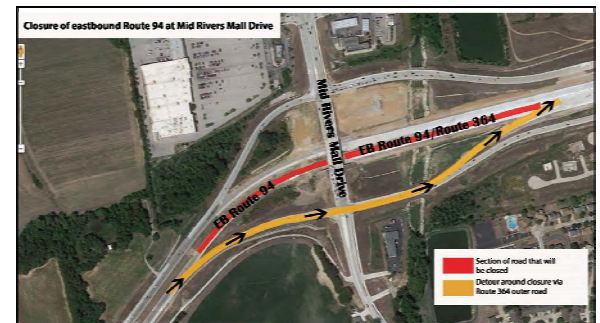
The entire nine mile stretch of Route 364/Page Phase 3 opens to traffic in several weeks. In order to make the final connection from Route 364/Page Phase 3 to the existing stretch of Route 364, MoDOT and its contractor, Page Constructors, will make two major traffic changes in the area of Route 94 and Mid Rivers Mall Drive.

Starting at 6 p.m. on Friday, September 26 crews will switch traffic on westbound Route 364/Route 94 to the new bridge. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and motorists coming from Mid Rivers Mall Drive will need to yield before merging with westbound Route 364/Route 94 traffic. The lanes will reopen by 5 a.m. Monday, September 29. At that time, motorists will have two lanes of traffic coming from westbound Route 364/Route 94 on the new bridge. This temporary traffic condition will remain in place until the new Route 364 opens.

After morning rush hour on Monday, September 29 crews will close all lanes of eastbound Route 94 at Mid Rivers Mall Drive. Traffic will be required to exit at Mid Rivers, go through the intersection and back onto eastbound Route 94/Route 364. The detour will be in place until the second half of the project opens in late October. For details on the changes, go to www.modot.org/Route364.

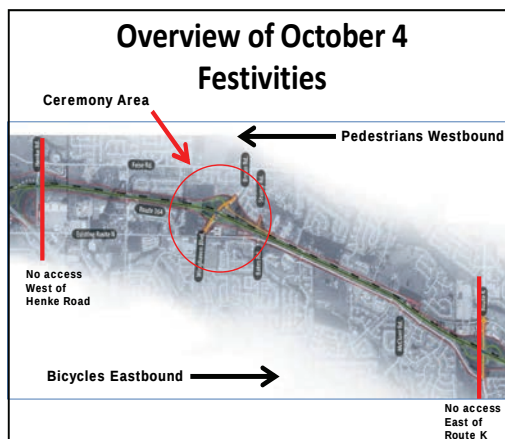


Map of westbound traffic changes.

Completion Countdown: Bike, Walk, Run on Route 364



The first half of the new Route 364/Page Phase 3 from Interstate 64 to Route K opens to traffic the weekend of October 4. Before the road opens to traffic, the public is invited to walk, run or ride their bikes on the road between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturday, October 4. A ribbon cutting ceremony will be held at 2 p.m. at the Bryan Road overpass.
