- The public is reminded not to enter the Route 364/Page Phase 3 project limits. Trespassing on an active construction site is extremely dangerous even when it appears no work is going on.
- Off-peak lane closures will continue on Route K while crews finish work in the area.
- There will still be off-peak lane closures on Route 364 once the road opens to traffic to allow crews to safely complete work in the area.
- The ramps from eastbound Route 364 to westbound Route 94/Mid Rivers Mall Drive and from Mid Rivers Mall Drive to westbound Route 364 will be completed later this fall.

Completion Countdown: I-64 to Route K Open to Traffic

Route 364 Frequently Asked Questions

- Why is there no access to I-64 or Route N from Henke Road?** Due to the proximity of Henke Road and I-64, there was not enough room to safely build ramps at both locations.
- Will fencing be installed along the corridor?** Yes, a 60-inch chain link fence will be installed along state property where it backs up to residential areas.

Completion Countdown: Second Half Opening Soon

Crews are hard at work finishing up the second half of the new Route 364/Page Phase 3. The driving lanes of Route 364 from Route K to Mid Rivers Mall Drive are scheduled to open to traffic during the weekend of October 31.

Once the section is open to traffic, there will still be some closures in place. The ramp from eastbound Route 364 to westbound Route 94/Mid Rivers Mall Drive, as well as the ramp from Mid Rivers Mall Drive to westbound Route 364 will be open to traffic later this fall.

Crews will also be continuing to work at the Route K and Route 364 interchange. Please use caution and slow down when traveling through those areas.
