

## **Changes Coming to Route 94 at South Breeze**

Big traffic changes are coming this summer to Route 94 at South Breeze Road. MoDOT will close the crossover at that location



to prevent drivers from turning left or going straight across Route 94. Special turn lanes, known as J-turns, will be added at Independence Road and between South Breeze and Wolfrum Road, so

drivers can access eastbound and westbound Route 94. Drivers will still be able to turn left from Route 94 onto South Breeze.

Work on the \$1.3 million project will start this summer and is expected to wrap up by the end of the year.

MoDOT will hold a second public meeting on the Route N Study later this month. Members of the study team will be available to discuss the various concepts being suggested for the stretch of Route N that runs from South Point Prairie to the Interstate 64/Route

364 interchange. The study began in August 2018 is expected to take about 15 months to complete.
