What's Going on? Winter Operation & Projects

We've come a long way with our Washington Bridge project! Our pedestrian trail was open to the public in September and our only major work remaining is the aesthetic lighting on the bridge. Due to Covid-19, we expect the work to be completed in 2021.

Another project taking place in Franklin County is slide repairs on Interstate 44. Crews will continue to close sections of I-44 for up to 15 minutes each during day time hours. In October, we worked between Gray Summit and Pacific, and Eureka and Pacific.



Route AD over Happy Sac Creek will be completed in mid-December 2020. Crews made the finishing touches and connected the new relocated pavement to existing pavement last month. The bridge replacement of approximately 0.32 miles has reopened to the public.
