Route A from Collins Road to Old Route 21

A lot of changed since the initial beginning of the pandemic, yet MoDOT is moving forward with a few projects.

In Jefferson County, Route A from Collins Road to Old Route 21 work will begin this summer! This work will include resurfacing, guardrail upgrades, and intersection improvements at Harrison Lake, Burning Tree, Pebble Creek and Morgan Road. Construction is expected to be completed by Winter 2021.

Route AH Over Interstate 44

Crews have begun repairing Route AH bridge over Interstate 44. Drivers should plan for additional travel time during the month of June.

Some work that will be completed is heat straightening the bent girders on Route AH and other bridge repair. The closures will be nightly during the week. Work will be completed in Fall 2021.
