ROLLA, Mo.- Missouri University of Science and Technology will host the 65th annual Missouri Asphalt Conference December 3-4, 2024, at the Diamond Event Center in Rolla.

Conference topics will include the following: Thick-lift Pavement Performance Improvement by Utilizing Highly Modified Asphalt Binders; Life Cycle Analysis panel discussion; Using FTIR to identify contaminants in asphalt binders; Climate Challenge Update; Alternative binders for high friction surface; Pelletized Recycled Asphalt Shingles; I-70 Design-Build Project Update; Intelligent compaction for automatic amplitude adjustment; What impact is AI having on asphalt industry/design?; Latest Research Advances in Asphalt; Work zone safety. What can be done to protect workers better?; MAPA updates; and MoDOT updates.
