SFY 2024 Legislatively Designated and Funded Initiatives

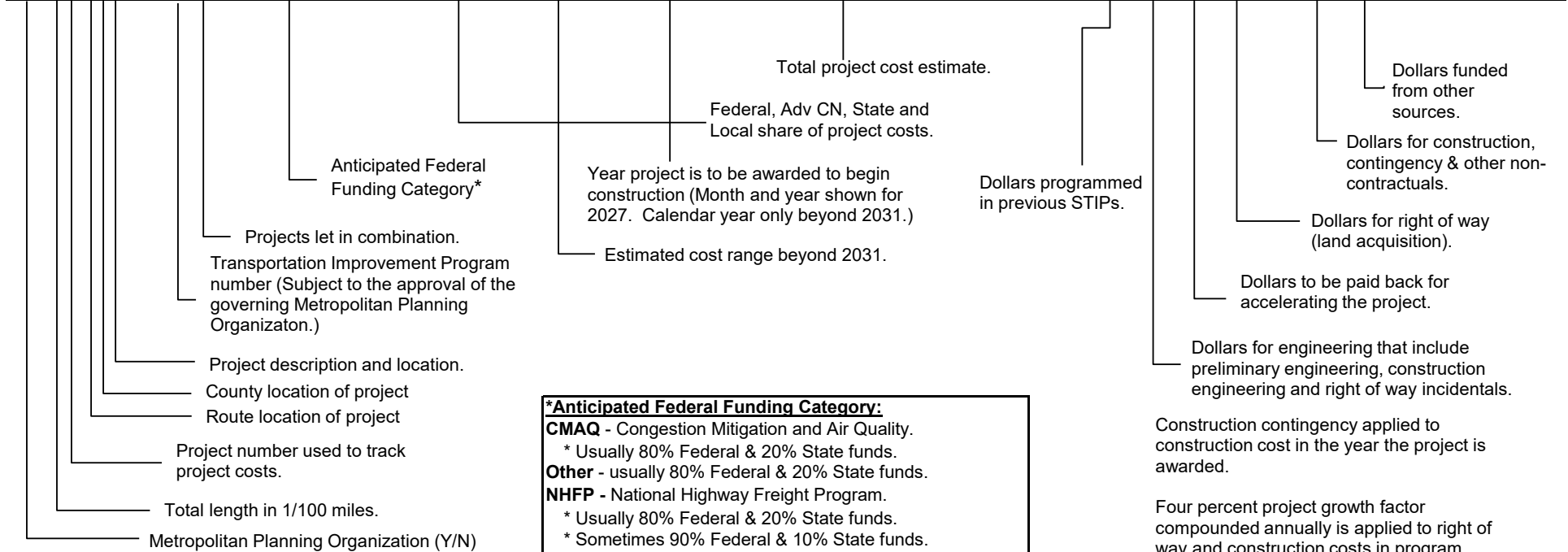
This section of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program contains projects funded by Missouri's General Assembly during the 2023 legislative session. These projects are funded by either General Revenue or bonding authorized by the General Assembly.

During the 2023 legislative session, the Missouri General Assembly addressed the top transportation need in the state, widening I-70. Missouri's FY 2024 budget from the General Assembly, supported by Governor Parson, provides General Revenue for the costs to plan, design, construct, reconstruct, rehabilitate, and repair three lanes in each direction on approximately 200 miles of I-70 from Blue Springs to Wentzville. The Improve I-70 program is programmed from FY 2024 through FY 2027.

The following is a list of those projects and their specifics, along with information about their funding and timing. MoDOT will track these projects and report regularly on their progress.
