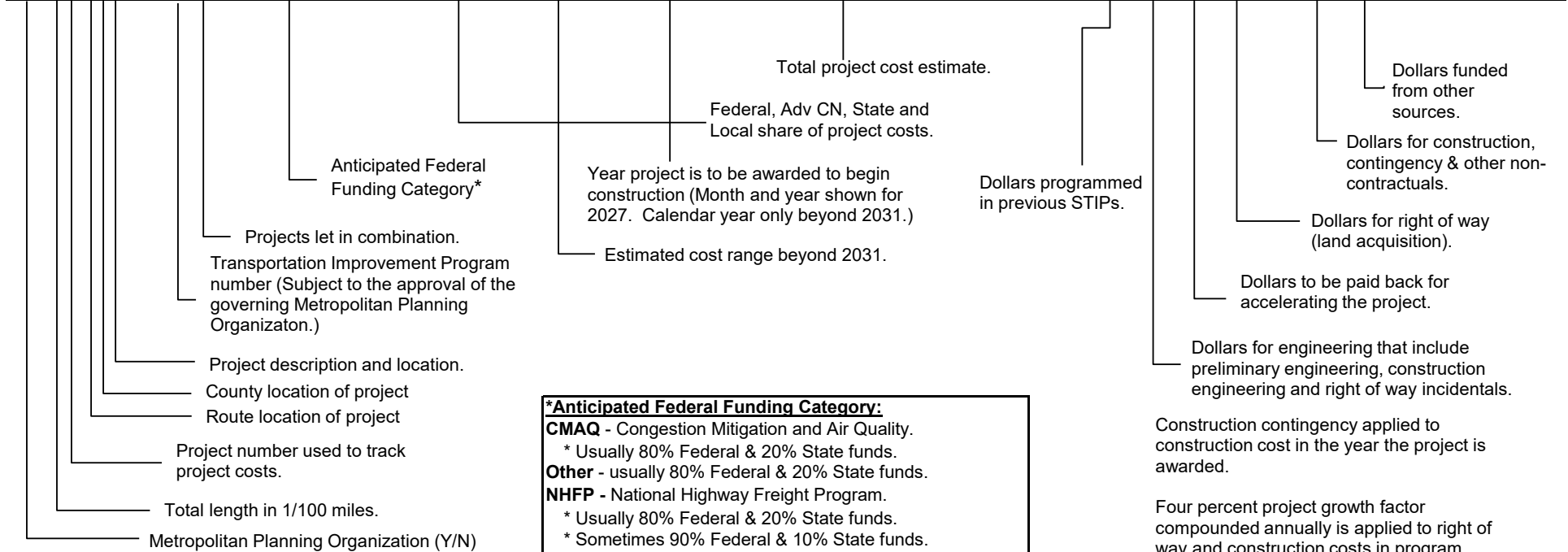
SFY 2026 Legislatively Designated and Funded Initiatives
