Construction of the Grand and Cass Avenue Corridor includes road resurfacing and streetscape improvements on the east side of Grand Boulevard from Natural Bridge to Cass Ave and the north side of Cass Avenue from Grand Blvd to Spring Ave. The proposed work includes but is not limited to: earthwork, removals, grading, paving, utility adjustments, street reconfiguration, traffic control, signals, street and pedestrian lighting, sidewalk, curbs, unit pavers, granite, trees, landscaping, and site furniture. The work consists of furnishing all material, labor, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary for the construction of the items noted above in accordance with all the requirements of these specifications, and the drawings made a part thereof. All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.
