

**INVITATION TO BID**  
**2024 Commercial Avenue Pedestrian Improvements**  
**Smithville, Missouri**

Sealed bids, addressed to the City of Smithville, Attn: Chuck Soules, 107 W. Main Street, Smithville, Missouri 64089 for the proposed work will be received by the City of Smithville, Missouri until **2:00 pm (prevailing local time) on Tuesday, July 30, 2024** at the office of the City Hall, 107 W. Main Street, Smithville, Missouri 64089, and at that time will be publicly opened. Bids should be delivered to: City of Smithville, Attn: Chuck Soules, 107 W. Main Street, Smithville, Missouri 64089.

The proposed work, hereinafter called the work, includes: Construction of approximately 2,127 Sq. Yds. of concrete sidewalk, 90 Sq. Yds. of concrete curb ramps, 887 Lin. Ft. of concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, 1,120 Sq. Yds. of 6" and 8" concrete pavement, 3 curb inlets, 95 Lin. Ft. of storm sewer (sizes 15" & 18"), retaining walls.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis as indicated in the Bid Form. Bid security in the amount of 5% shall be furnished in accordance with the Notice to Contractors and shall be on the Bid Bond Form included in this Invitation to Bid.

The City of Smithville reserves the right to reject any or all bids. **The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.**

Following registration, complete sets of Bidding Documents may be downloaded from the Issuing Office's website as "zipped" portable document format (PDF) files. The cost of printed Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office will depend on the number and size of the Drawings and Project Manual, applicable taxes, and shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder. Cost of Bidding Documents and shipping is non-refundable. Contract Documents will be shipped only if the requesting party assumes responsibility for all related shipping charges. Non-refundable corporate, certified, or cashier's checks shall be made payable to Drexel Technologies. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Smithville hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri 2024 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this Project.
