

Route 61/67 at St. Johns Church Road & Miller Road East Improvements

Why is this project needed?

The purpose of this project is to improve safety on Route 61/67 at the intersection of St. Johns Church Road and the intersection of Miller Road East in Arnold, MO.


The following improvements will be made to the intersection of Route 61/67 and St. Johns Church Road:

- Install a four-way traffic signal at the intersection
- Add a right-turn lane to southbound 61/67 north of the intersection
- Add a left-turn lane to St. Johns Church Road and stripe Linderhof Drive to add thru and leftturn lane pavement markings
- Resurface Route 61/67 within project limits

The following improvements will be made to the intersection of Route 61/67 and Miller Road East:

- Realign Miller Road East to coincide with strip mall entrance
- Widen Miller Road East to accommodate two thru lanes and a turning lane
- Install a four-way traffic signal at the intersection
- Widen both directions of Route 61/67 to accommodate turn lanes
- Widen southbound Route 61/67 north of Miller Road East for the addition of a right-turn lane
- Add pedestrian crossing south of Miller Road East, between Pleasant View Motel and strip mall
- Resurface Route 61/67 within project limits

Adding these improvements will improve the safety and reduce the number of crashes, as well as help overall traffic flow on Route 61/67.



What are the anticipated impacts?

Construction details have not been finalized at this time. MoDOT will work with business owners and residents to ensure that access is available during construction.

What is the anticipated project schedule?

Contract Award	Spring 2024
Construction Begins	Summer 2024
Construction Complete	Summer 2025

Is MoDOT purchasing property from landowners?

MoDOT will need to purchase some property and/or obtain permanent and temporary easements to construct the additional lane through the project limits. A Right of Way representative will be contacting affected landowners during the summer of 2022 to begin the acquisition process.

How much will this project cost?

The cost of construction is estimated at \$1.5 million.
