Pleasant St., Aurora, Missouri 65605, and at that time will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Project Description: The project will consist of the construction of a new, approximately 3,400-foot long 10-foot wide pedestrian trail, excavation and vegetative restoration together with any incidental work to the pedestrian walkway and existing stormwater system.
