This Addendum is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents to the same extent as if they were originally included therein. This Addendum shall be inserted in the Contract Documents and **shall be executed and submitted with the Bid**. This Addendum includes the following:

### Contract Documents

1. **Proposal**, Page 3, Item No. 8 – TIME FOR COMPLETION: The number of working days shall be changed to **60**. The Contractor shall complete the project within 60 working days after the date of the Notice to Proceed.

### Specifications

1. **JSP G – Topsoil**, Page JSP -7, Paragraph concerning Guaranty and Replacement shall be removed and replaced with the following:

Acceptance / Corrective Action: Refer to sections 805.4 and 805.5, respectively in the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition. It will be the contractor's responsibility to clean and remove any spoils, and reestablish vegetation in all disturbed areas following construction.

2. **Appendix A, Section 02900 - PLANTING**

- a. Paragraph 3.07 (A): Any reference to a one year establishment period to be carried out by the contractor shall be deleted. However, the Contractor shall obtain a transferable warranty from the nursery in which all plantings are obtained. Upon completion of the maintenance period and once the work has been accepted by the City the Contractor shall provide a transferred warranty from the nursery to the City in writing. The maintenance period shall be for 60 days after planting, at which time an inspection of the work will be conducted. Inadequate plantings shall be corrected within the time period agreed upon at the contractor's expense.
- b. General: If planting is to be conducted in the spring time, the contractor shall plant "**chilled**" Daffodils.

Drawings

1. **Drawing No. 8 – Profile Sheet**, Clarification: Profile elevations have been provided as a general guideline only. They are provided to represent the expected conditions on site. The contractor shall be required to make any and all adjustments to the profile as necessary to meet ADA requirements and promote drainage of all areas.
2. **Image for Historic District Sign**, The slogan "Come for a Day; Stay for a Lifetime" shall be changed to:

Come for a Day  
or  
Stay for a Lifetime
