# **OPEN SESSION**

Mr. Coffey made a motion to go into Open Session. Lt. Burgun seconded; motion carried.

<u>Consideration of Consent Agenda Items</u>– (It is the understanding of the Board for those items to be reviewed before the Board Meeting and will only be discussed if necessary) Consent Agenda items were as follows:

Mr. Coffey made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda items. Lt. Burgun seconded; motion carried.

<u>Anthem Claims Summary (2022/2023)</u> – Mr. Denkler reported Plan medical claim payouts have decreased 13.3% when compared to 2022 through the seventh month of the 2023 calendar year.

### MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2022/2023) -

Mr. Denkler reported Plan prescription claim costs have increased 28.4% when compared to 2022 through the seventh month of the 2023 calendar year.

Anthem - Mr. Denkler welcomed Anthem staff to the meeting.

<u>**2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Update-**</u> Mr. Makowski presented the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter report to the Board. Current medical spend is down 7.6% per member per month when compared to the prior reporting period. Top two health conditions for the Plan's population are cancer and musculoskeletal. Monitoring these conditions and spend in our population can help inform strategies to help members.

<u>MedImpact Quarterly Report-</u>Mr. Denkler welcomed MedImpact staff to the meeting.
<u>2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Update-</u> Ms. Paslaski and Mr. Ha reviewed the 2nd quarter report package with the Board. Plan paid per member per month is at \$127.43, which is an increase of 32.1% for CY 2023 when compared to CY2022. This increase was mainly due to drug mix. Though the numbers are up, the Plan continues to outperform the benchmarks.

### **Other Business-**

Open Enrollment update- Benefit update is being printed and going out in the mail in a week or two. This is an open enrollment year for Active Employees. Staff is being

proactive with the Medicare population; to reduce dual enrollment issues and notifying members quickly when that situation arises.

MetLife- Staff has met with the new carrier three times and meetings are going well.

Mr. Padgett made a motion to adjourn at 10:29 am. Mr. Reeser seconded; motion carried.
