OPEN SESSION

The meeting was called to order at 8:02 a.m.

<u>Consideration of Consent Agenda Items</u>— (It is the understanding of the Board for those items to be reviewed before the Board Meeting and will only be discussed if necessary) Consent Agenda items were as follows:

Mr. Reeser made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda items. Lt. Burgun seconded; motion carried.

<u>Anthem Claims Summary (2021/2022)</u> – Ms. Halford reported Plan medical claim payouts have increased 8.4% when compared to 2021 through the seventh month of the 2022 calendar year.

MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2021/2022) -

Ms. Halford reported Plan prescription claim costs have increased 15.1% when compared to 2021 through the seventh month of the 2022 calendar year.

MedImpact Quarterly Report- Ms. Halford welcomed MedImpact staff to the meeting.

2nd Quarter Update- Ms. Paslaski and Ms. Bellanti reviewed the 2nd quarter report package with the Board. Plan paid per member per month is at \$96.44, which is an increase of 13.2% for CY 2022 when compared to CY2021. This increase was mainly due to drug mix. Though the numbers are up, the Plan continues to outperform the benchmarks.

<u>Anthem</u> - Ms. Halford welcomed Anthem staff to the meeting.

2nd Quarter Update- Mr. Makowski presented the 2nd quarter report to the Board. Current medical spend is up 16.2% per member per month when compared to the prior reporting period. 95.1% of total claims were paid in network with a total of 49.3% of network discounts.

Other Business- Ms. Halford gave a monthly COVID-19 update along with the impacts on the Plan. Total COVID-19 medical spend since the beginning of the pandemic has been just over \$16 million.

EAC Concern- Ms. Halford informed the Board of an EAC concern for hearing aid coverage due to the nature of our employee's work. The Board will take the recommendation under consideration and encourages the employee to seek out other resources that may be available through their employer &/or retirement system.

Lt. Burgun made a motion to adjourn at 10:42 a.m.. Ms. Crawford seconded; motion carried.
