

The Missouri Department of Transportation is proposing to amend the state's five-year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

A 7-day public comment period regarding the amendment begins October 24, 2018 and ends October 31, 2018. The proposed November amendment is attached below. The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission, the Federal Highway Administration, and the Federal Transit Administration approved the current Statewide Transportation Improvement Program in July 2018. Amendments occur due to unforeseen circumstances, changing conditions, or new opportunities that require a more rapid response than can be provided by an annual update.
