Backup Alarm Retrofit



Description and Benefit

Often on construction project sites or when leaving the Project Office garage, a driver is alone while operating a vehicle. If backing is required, and no spotter is available, there is risk to others in the vicinity. On a busy project site or at the Project Office, increasing awareness of a backing vehicle is a simple step to increase safety. This back up alarm utilizes a vehicles trailer wiring harness. Anytime the vehicle is shifted into reverse, the backup alarm sounds. The backup alarm alerts passersby that the driver may have limited vision. The attention-grabbing sound of the alarm helps to ensure the awareness of anyone in the surrounding space. The goal is simple: prevent accidents by informing pedestrians and drivers that a vehicle is reversing.
