Bring Forward Supplements External Procedure

Overview

Brought Forward Supplements (BFS) is an automated process, conditional upon closed renewals, where a vehicle which wasn't originally included in the renewal supplement is brought forward from the current registration into the next registration period.

Regulation

7 CSR 10-25.030(8) Apportion Registration pursuant to the International Registration Plan

(8) Upon completion of initial or renewal applications, subsequent applications may be filed during the current registration year to—

Process

A BFS is only necessary around renewal time. If the carrier adds/updates vehicles in the current registration, the information will only automatically add/update in the next registration period if the renewal is closed and the 'Add Supplement to Renewal Year' box is marked within the supplement.

- If the renewal is not started or is still open/invoiced, this box cannot be used.
- 1. The following supplements provide the option to bring forward the information:
 - a. Add Vehicle
 - b. Add/Transfer Vehicle
 - c. Cab Card Correction
- 2. The carrier will select the 'Add Supplement to Renewal Year' checkbox on the billing page of the supplement.

Add Supplement to Renewal Year

- 3. Once that supplement is approved and closed, the system will automatically generate the BFS in the next registration period.
- 4. The BFS will be brought forward in an Open/Pending status.

5. The system will create a comment in Web processing indicating the supplement is a BFS.
