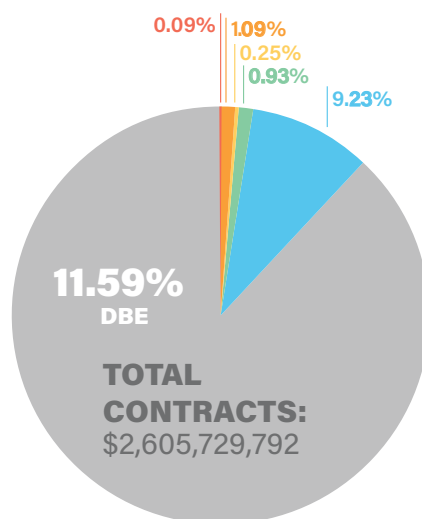


# Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

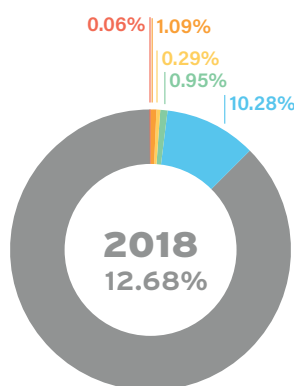

## STATEWIDE TOTAL FFY 18-20

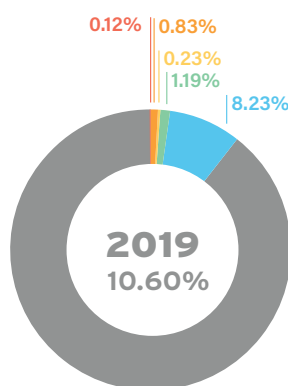

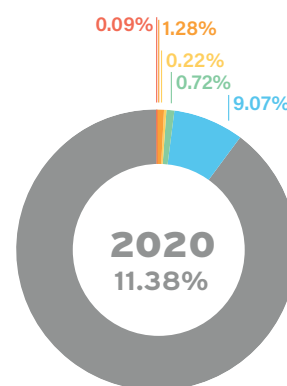
