

CEDAR COUNTY ROUTE M/BEAR CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT NEAR STOCKTON

PROJECT FACTS

- Replace Route M bridge over Bear Creek
- Widen bridge to 24 feet to accommodate two 12-foot lanes
- New bridge will include new barrier walls, object markers, guardrail and permanent striping



CONSTRUCTION

- Construction to begin in 2023
- Estimated Total Cost: \$1.7 million

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Route M CLOSED at Bear • Creek for up to three (3) months during construction
- Detour: Route 32, Route J, Route N

BRIDGE FACTS

- Bridge built in 1953
- Approximately 755 vehicles per day use the bridge
- Current bridge is a single lane
- Current bridge is 14 feet wide, 165 feet long
