Manufactured articles, materials and equipment shall be applied, installed, connected, erected, used, cleaned and conditioned as directed by the manufacturer.

Materials, supplies and equipment shall be in accordance with samples submitted by the Contractor and approved by the Engineer.

Materials, supplies or equipment to be incorporated into the work shall not be purchased by the contractor or the subcontractor subject to a chattel mortgage or under a conditional sale contract or other agreement by which an interest is retained by the seller.

## VII. INSPECTION & TESTING:

All materials and equipment used in the construction of the project shall be subject to adequate inspection and testing in accordance with generally accepted standards, as required and defined in the contract documents.

~~The City shall provide all inspections and testing services. not required by the contract documents.~~

~~The Contractor shall provide at his expense the testing and inspection services required by the contract documents.~~

If the contract documents, laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or orders of any public authority having jurisdiction require any work to specifically be inspected, tested, or approved by someone other than the contractor, the contractor will give the Engineer timely notice or readiness. The contractor will then furnish the Engineer the required certificates of inspection, testing or approval.

The Engineer and his representatives will at all times have access to the work. In addition, authorized representatives and agents of any participating federal or state agency shall be permitted to inspect all work, materials, payroll records of personnel, invoices or materials, and other relevant data and records. The contractor will provide proper facilities for such access and observation of the work, and also for any inspection or testing thereof.

If any work is covered contrary to the written instruction of the Engineer, it must, if requested by the Engineer, be uncovered for his observation and replaced at the contractor's expense.

If the Engineer considers it necessary or advisable that covered work be inspected or tested by others, the contractor, at the Engineer's request, will uncover, expose or otherwise make available for observation, inspection or testing as the Engineer may require, that portion of the work in question, furnishing all necessary labor, materials, tools, and equipment. If it is found that such work is defective, the contractor will bear all the expenses of such uncovering, exposure, observation, inspection and
