The General Services Department of Kansas City, Missouri will receive sealed Bids until **2:00 PM, on Tuesday, January 24, 2023** at City Hall, 1st Floor, Room 102W, Kansas City, Missouri 64106 for **Project No. 89008260 Federal Aid Project STP-3451(402) NW Waukomis Drive Complete Streets Upgrade**. Bids will be opened after that time at the same location.

The proposed work includes the reconstruction of NW Waukomis from the north side of NW Englewood Blvd to approximately 1,000 feet north of NW 62nd Street. Project includes two bridge replacements and associated streambank stabilization work, asphalt pavement, curb & gutters, sidewalks, multiuse trail, driveways, storm sewers, street lighting, and landscaping.

A prime contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date if this project involves roadway or bridge work. DBE will need to be on MRCC approved list.

Each bidder must certify that it is not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any federal agency and they have not been convicted or had civil judgment rendered within the past 3 years.

For this Project the DBE goal is **12%**.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

ALL EMBANKMENT SHALL CONSIST OF SUITABLE MATERIAL THAT IS ENTIRELY IMPERISHABLE WITH THAT PORTION PASSING THE NO. 40 SIEVE HAVING ALIQUID LIMIT NOT EXCEEDING 40 AND A PLASTIC INDEX NOT EXCEEDING 25, WHEN TESTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM D-4318. NO EMBANKMENT IS TO BE PLACED WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS.
