Sealed bids for Public Improvements for, Truman Boulevard Extension, will be received at: City of Nixa - Public Works, 1111 W. Kathryn Street, Nixa, Missouri, 65714 until 2:00 PM (Prevailing Local Time) on the 23rd day of June 2022, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed, addressed to the City of Nixa – Public Works, 1111 W. Kathryn Street, Nixa, Missouri and designated as bid for PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR TRUMAN BOULEVARD ROADWAY EXTENSION. Note: The use of face masks may be required within the facility.

The proposed work includes: The construction of new pavement and a roundabout between Heather Glenn and Pembroke. This work includes ADA ramps, sidewalk, curb and gutter construction, driveway construction, storm work, and all other miscellaneous work required for completion of the project. This proposed work is being let as a combination bid with PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR WATERLINE AND ELECTRICAL EXTENSION. Both projects must be bid on in combination to be considered as a responsive bid.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Nixa hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) calendar days of beginning work on the construction project. No matter what date the contractor chooses to begin the project, **the project must be completed on or before June 16, 2023.**

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Nixa reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 7%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

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TRUMAN BOULEVARD WATERLINE AND ELECTRICAL EXTENSIONS**

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The proposed work includes: The proposed work includes the extension of a main waterline and electrical extension along Truman Boulevard. This proposed work is being let as a combination bid with PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS FOR TRUMAN BOULEVARD ROADWAY EXTENSION. Both projects must be bid on in combination to be considered a responsive bid.

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A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

This bid must be included in combination with the Truman Boulevard Extension Project. The project award will be for the combination of the two contract bids. The City of Nixa reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 0%.
