Sealed bids for J9P3664 5th Street Intersection Improvmenets, will be received at: City of West Plains, 1910 Holiday Lane, West Plains, MO 65775 until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 3rd day of August, 2021, at the office of the City Administrator, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of Paper Copies.

The proposed work includes: A new signalized intersection at 5th Street and US Highway 63, a roundabout at the intersection of 5th Street and Kentucky Avenue, street lighting and sidewalks.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 PM on the 20th day of July 2021, at 1910 Holiday Lane, West Plains, MO 65775. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the state wage rate.

The City of West Plains, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of West Plains, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
