City of Marshall College and Miami Street Sidewalk Improvement

Located along West College Street and South Miami Avenue between Break Time on West College Street to the east side of South Miami Avenue and south along South Miami Avenue to Vers Street in City of Marshall, Missouri, and

WILL be received and opened publicly at the office of City of Marshall, City Hall, 214 N. Lafayette Avenue, Marshall, Missouri 65340 at **2:00 PM. on Wednesday, October 14, 2026.**

Any and all bids received after the time specified above will be returned unopened.

The proposed work consists of grading, paving, and drainage to provide ADA compliant sidewalk from east side of Break Time on West College Street to the east side of South Miami Avenue and south along South Miami Avenue to Vers Street.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 o'clock A.M on September 30, 2026, at the City of Marshall City Hall, 214 Lafayette Avenue, Marshall, Missouri 65340. All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.

The City of Marshall hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, July 2026 including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7-days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. The City of Marshall reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 0.0%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
