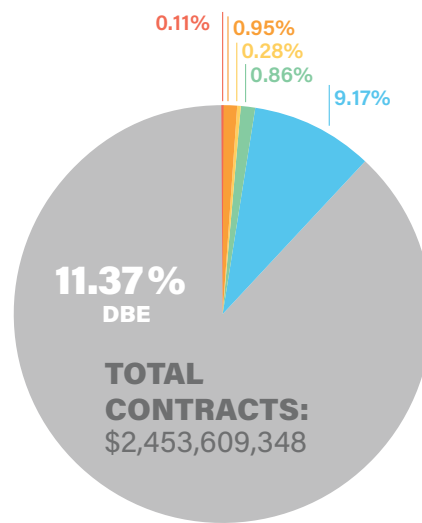


# Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

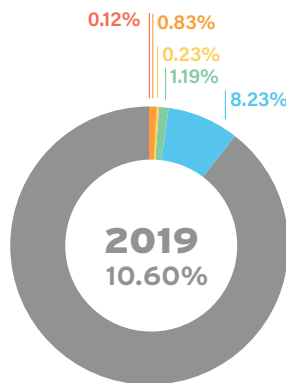

## STATEWIDE TOTAL FFY 19-21

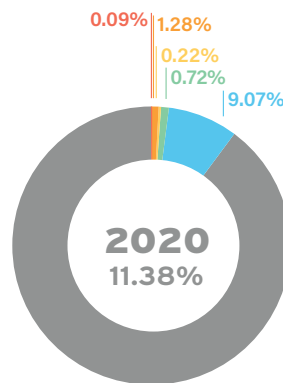

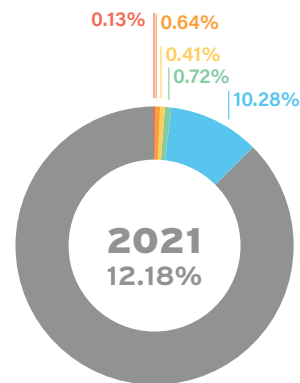
