

Dade County Route 160 Bridge Rehabilitations

Over Turnback Creek & Lynne Branch (Stockton Lake) East of Greenfield

Project Facts:

- ♦ Replace the decks (driving surface) of both bridges, install new bridge walls and guardrail
- ♦ Built in 1967, the bridges are severely deteriorating
- ♦ Approximately 970 vehicles cross the bridges per day



Traffic Impacts:

- ♦ The bridges CLOSED one at a time
- ♦ Route 160 CLOSED at each bridge during construction
- ♦ Access to property maintained on either side of bridges, but not traffic allowed in work zones
- ♦ During bridge construction, Route 160 traffic will be detoured on Dade County Route O

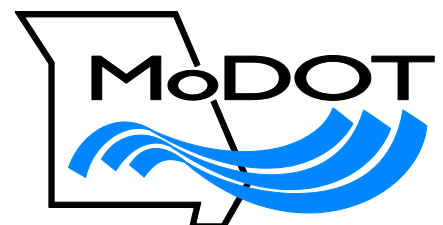


Construction: Spring 2020 to fall 2020
